Our school is located in the heart of Mount Maunganui, in a beautifully restored heritage building. Our place is very social; we have a large garden area as well as two covered courtyards and deck areas, spacious classrooms with natural light, two large student lounges, a kitchen and outdoor BBQ. There are musical instruments and sports equipment for students to use whenever they want.

Students can walk to the beach, cafés, the supermarket and sports areas.





The school size depends on the season:

Low season: (April - August) around 40 students

Shoulder season: (September - December) around 50 students

High season: (January - March) around 65 students









Mount Maunganui Language Centre is registered as a Private Training Establishment by the New Zealand Qualifications Authority, and holds CATEGORY 1 status, the highest level achievable under the NZQA system.

Students who study for 14 weeks or more on a student visa are allowed to work part time up to 20 hours per week.






Our school is mostly made up of adults students, with some junior students coming for short stays at specific times of the year. The average age of our students in 2024 was 23. The oldest student was 75, and the youngest was 14. We are set up to cater to all age groups and all different cultures.

The school is in central Mount Maunganui, close to shops, restaurants, cafes, sports facilities and of course the beach - which is only 800 metres away.

Students are picked up by our shuttle service and brought directly to Mount Maunganui, the journey takes around 2.5 hours.

We can also arrange a direct domestic flight, which takes just 25 minutes from Auckland to Tauranga.



Many of our homestay families are all within walking distance of the beach, and most are located within 10 kilometres of the school. Most students come to school on foot, by bicycle, or bus. The average time to get to school is 25 minutes.

Students can also choose to stay in the Student House, located just a short walk away from the school. A private room and shared kitchen, bathrooms and living room are available.

In addition to homestay, students are able to book accommodation in the Student House located a short walk from the school:

The house is a two-storey, three bedroom home, located 7 minutes' walk from the school. It is fully furnished and features:

- Three private, lockable bedrooms
- Two bathrooms
- Living room, dining area
- Full size kitchen with dishwasher, oven, microwave, fridge
- TV, Wi-Fi
- Power and water included
- Upstairs deck, downstairs garden
- Secure garage for bikes, sports equipment etc
- Washing machine and rubbish disposal included













Most students come to us with the same problem - they've done some English study in their lives but they struggle to communicate in English. So our classes focus on building students' fluency and communication skills. We teach from a 360° approach - including grammar, speaking, listening, reading, writing, and pronunciation. Students can track their progress through regular assessment tests, and additional help is always available. All students also have free access to our app for extra study after class. We can also create an Individual Learning Plan (ILP) for students with specific goals.

On the first day students should be at school by 8.45 am. Students are given an orientation programme which involves an explanation of all school policies and procedures, school tour, introduction to key staff members, and level testing for class placement. Testing involves a grammar test, a writing component, and an interview.

Learning doesn't finish at the end of class, so we offer a wide range of trips, sports, cultural and leisure activities for students both after school and on weekends. Students can use their English in a relaxed situation to build stronger relationships with their friends from other countries.
